

What is the Saddleback Valley Volleyball Club?

The Saddleback Valley Volleyball Club is a volleyball coach run organization with the following primary goals.

- 1) To teach volleyball skills and teamwork to young developing athletes in our area.
- 2) To raise the level of play at the surrounding high schools.
- 3) To provide competition on local, state, and national levels for our teams.
- 4) To assist players in obtaining college scholarships when they qualify through grades, entrance exams, attitude, and ability.
- 5) To provide a home for volleyball enthusiasts of all ages.

Our club is part of the national volleyball program administered by USA Volleyball Association. Our current club members range in age from 8 to 18 (USVBA competition age brackets include 18 & under, 16 & under, 14 & under, and 12 & under.)

How long is the club season?

We expect that the majority of our players will attend the VB Festival at the end of June. Their season will last from the middle of November to the end of June.

For those teams not attending the VB Festival, their season will end with the SCVA Regional Tournament held in June

When, where and how often are club practices?

All teams, with the exception of the 12& under, will practice three times weekly. Practices are two hours in length for school nights (18's are 2 ½ hours.) Saturday practices are from 2 to 2 ½ for all teams. Practices start at 4pm and finish by 10pm mid-week. They start at 8am and finish by 6pm on Saturday.

All practices are held at the seven- court SVVC facility.

When and where are tournaments held?

Monthly tournament sites are determined by the SCVA during the week prior to each tournament. In most instances, these are held in the Los Angeles/Orange County area. Most are within an hour or less of our facility. You can view the competition schedule at www.scvavolleyball.org.

What if my daughter participates in other school sports?

Our volleyball club has many student athletes participating in high school sports. We encourage this participation as long as the student maintains a good academic standing, good health, and is able to give adequate time and effort to each sport. Please keep in mind that club volleyball is a team sport that requires a significant time commitment.

Are there other possible costs involved?

Yes. If overnight lodging and/or van rental is required for any tournament, each attending player will be billed per actual expense.

A few teams will qualify for special 2 and 3-day tournaments (Las Vegas Invitational, and Junior National Qualifying). The cost of these tournaments is not included in monthly dues. Each participating player will pay his or her own expenses, including a nonrefundable entry fee.

Are there ways to offset some or all of the Club costs?

Yes, yearbook ad sales. Players receive 100% of the ad costs, ask the club administrators for sales materials.

Players may obtain their own sponsor(s). Other possible assistance opportunities may be available, contact the club administrator.
